1. **George Oberdorff** – Born January 31, 1860 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died February 1, 1939 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Windsor Cemetery in Windsor Twp, York County, PA
2. **Amanda Wallick** – Born October 5, 1855 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died August 30, 1928 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Windsor Cemetery in Windsor Twp, York County, PA.

Location of residence

- Based on the route that was taken by the census worker and the households visited before and after the Oberdorff household, they probably lived somewhere in the vicinity of the intersection of Main St & Broadway. Considering Amanda is the daughter of Henry Wallick, it is possible they were residing in a residence that was owned and on the property of Henry Wallick. Henry owned property on all 4 corners of what is now Main St. and Broadway, and he also owned a large section of land along the first block of East Broadway.

- George worked as a cigar maker according to the 1880 census
