1. **Charles Neff** – Born October 18, 1824 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died June 10, 1904 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Home Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA.
2. **Matilda Hartman** – Born December 31, 1825 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died October 9, 1904 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Home Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA.
3. **Nathaniel Neff** – Born November 26, 1848 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died December 18, 1882 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Home Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA.
4. **Catherine Neff** – Born March 30, 1853 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died June 28, 1928 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA. She married **William Taylor** who was born November 17, 1854 (per tombstone), died February 7, 1935 (per tombstone) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA.
5. **Elizabeth Neff** – Born April 11, 1854 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died July 4, 1931 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Home Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA.
6. **Martin Neff** – Born January 15, 1859 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died June 26, 1935 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA.

8. **Jane Neff** – Born February 6, 1863 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died August 19, 1932 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA. She married **William A Grove** who was born March 27, 1862 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died July 10, 1936 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA.
9. **Abraham Neff** – Born October 25, 1864 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died February 12, 1954 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried in the mausoleum at the Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA. He married **Lovina Frey** who was born June 20, 1868 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died December 21, 1948 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried in the mausoleum at the Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA.
10. **Matilda Neff** – Born April 10, 1866 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died February 22, 1938 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA. She married **Samuel Grove** who was born February 15, 1871 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died November 11, 1953 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA.
11. **Alice Neff** – Born January 7, 1868 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died September 6, 1958 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA. She married **Charles Rost** who was born August 26, 1867 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died July 19, 1937 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA.

### Location of residence

- Beach Nichols 1876 Atlas of York County shows Chas. Neff living south of Country Club Road and on the west side of Dairyland Drive. This portion of Red Lion later withdrew and became part of York Township again. The house is still in existence today and is located at 850 Country Club Rd.



### Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- Charles is listed as a Farmer on the 1880 census
- In 1884, Charles was one of the petitioners to secede from Red Lion borough and his property went back to York Township.
- Catherine and her husband William Taylor resided in town at 330 W Broadway according census records and city directories. No occupation is listed for Catherine on census records.
- Elizabeth lived in Red Lion and census records indicate she lived on First Avenue and then later at 550 W Broadway (It is a duplex and her brother Wesley lived in the other half of the house at 548). She worked as a cigar maker.
- Martin lived in Red Lion on First Avenue before eventually moving to 130 W Broadway according to city directories. He was a cigar manufacturer and his factory was located along Church Alley,

just to the east of what is now the municipal building. In 1907, Martin was President of the Red Lion School Board. Martin was also elected to the Board of Director's for the People's State Bank of Red Lion.

- Wesley lived in Red Lion at 548 W Broadway and worked as a laborer and cigar maker.
- Jane and her husband William Grove lived in Red Lion at 318 W Broadway according to census records and city directories, no occupation was listed for Jane on any census records.
- Abraham Neff lived in Red Lion at 346 W Broadway according to census records and city directories, which is now the location of Turkey Hill. He was a cigar maker and packer.
- Matilda was single in 1900 and lived on Marietta St in Red Lion as a cigar maker. She married Samuel Grove in 1902 and later they lived at what was then 173 First Avenue (now 175 First Avenue) according to city directories and census records.
- Alice and her husband Charles Rost lived in Red Lion, first at 201 W High St and then eventually moved to 171 N Charles St. No occupation is listed for her on any census records.

#### **Miscellaneous Notes**

- As mentioned previously, Charles's property was part of Red Lion that seceded and went back to becoming part of York Township in 1884.
- Alice's husband Charles Rost is also an original Red Lion resident from 1880, more information on their contributions to Red Lion will be listed under their family's fact sheet.
