### Individual Information

1. **Henry Wagman** – Born January 5, 1821 in Germany (per tombstone), died December 23, 1886 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Saint Joseph’s Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA.
2. **Gertrude Decker** – Born March 17, 1825 in Germany (per tombstone), died July 18, 1881 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Saint Joseph’s Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA. Census records go back and forth with her name being Catherine or Gertrude.
3. **Annie Wagman** – Born about 1856 in York County, PA. She married **Albert Weis** who was born about 1858.
4. **Henry Wagman** – Born April 8, 1859 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died June 1, 1904 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Saint Joseph’s Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA. He married **Kate Crumbling** who was born May 29, 1867 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died November 19, 1947 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Mount Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden Twp, York County, PA.
5. **Magdalena Wagman** – Born May 1, 1862 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died January 8, 1937 in MD (per tombstone) and buried at Mount Holy Redeemer Cemetery in Baltimore, MD. She married **Henry Bisker** who was born December 9, 1853 in PA (per tombstone), died September 5, 1926 in MD (per tombstone) and buried at Mount Holy Redeemer Cemetery in Baltimore, MD.
6. **Martin Wagman** – Born August 30, 1869 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died October 12, 1933 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Saint Joseph’s Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA. He married **Alice Hildebrand** who was born March 26, 1874 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died November 19, 1947 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Saint Joseph’s Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA

### Location of residence

- Beach Nichols 1876 Atlas of York County shows H. Wagman living along what is now S. Franklin St., south of Country Club Road. Although another house is also marked H. Wagman, on the 1860 Shearer map of York County, Henry Wagman was living at the property highlighted below. Plus, with the census taker going from west to east along Country Club Rd, this is the next home they would encounter after visiting the William Paules household. After Henry was visited, his son John was visited followed by Daniel Spotts and then Henry Neff.
- The home is still in existence today and is located at 309 S. Franklin Street



### Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- Henry is listed as a Farmer on the 1880 census and was elected as the first Chief Burgess (now the position of Mayor) in Red Lion from 1880-1882.
- Martin lived along N. Main St in Red Lion according to the 1900 census and 1898 city directory and worked as a cigar maker. By 1910 he left Red Lion and was living in York Township

### Miscellaneous Notes

- Annie and her husband Albert Weis along with Magdalena and her husband Henry Bisker moved to MD before the 1900 census. Henry Jr. lived in York Township.
