1. **John Wise** – Born September 27, 1803 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died October 1, 1884 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Saint Luke's Evangelical Lutheran Cemetery in Chanceford Twp, York County, PA
2. **Christiana Dipple** – Born December 17, 1807 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died September 24, 1888 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Dallastown Union Cemetery in Dallastown, York County, PA.
3. **Margaret Runkle** – Born about 1863 in PA (per 1880 census)

Location of residence

- Beach Nichols 1876 Atlas of York County shows J. Wise living to the east of S. Main St. and to the west of the Ma & Pa Railroad tracks. This home is still in existence today, it is located on the north side of Marshall Street, just east of the current border of Red Lion and within Windsor Twp.



Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- John Wise was elected for a 2-year term as Auditor in the 1880 Red Lion election, but it is unclear if this was John Wise or his son John A. Wise.

Miscellaneous Notes

- As mentioned previously, John's residence is no longer within the boundary of Red Lion borough, it now sits just to the east of town along Marshall Street.
- John is the father of John A. Wise, who was also an original Red Lion resident.
- Nothing further is known about Margaret Runkle as there are several Margaret "Maggie" Runkle's born around this timeframe in southeastern York County.
