
Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- John A. Wise is listed as a farmer in the 1880, 1900 and 1920 census records. He also served on the building committee for St. John's Reformed Church in 1882 (per the Golden Jubilee Book)
- John A. Wise Jr. was single and lived with his father and then his sister Sarah. Census records indicate he was a farm laborer.
- Sarah and her husband John Gebhard lived at what is now 264 E. Broadway starting in 1884 (per Golden Jubilee Book)
- Annie and her husband John Taylor lived at what is now 255 S. Main St.
- Ida and her husband Noah Stabley lived at what is now 220 S. Main St. According to census records, before they lived at that address they lived at what was then 229 S. Main St, which was

- a large woodworking business operated by her husband and was located right next door to what is now 220 S. Main St (at the time it was 221 S. Main St)
- Edward and his wife Ada lived at what is now 327 S. Main St. According to census records, Edward worked as a carpenter and as a wood-worker.
