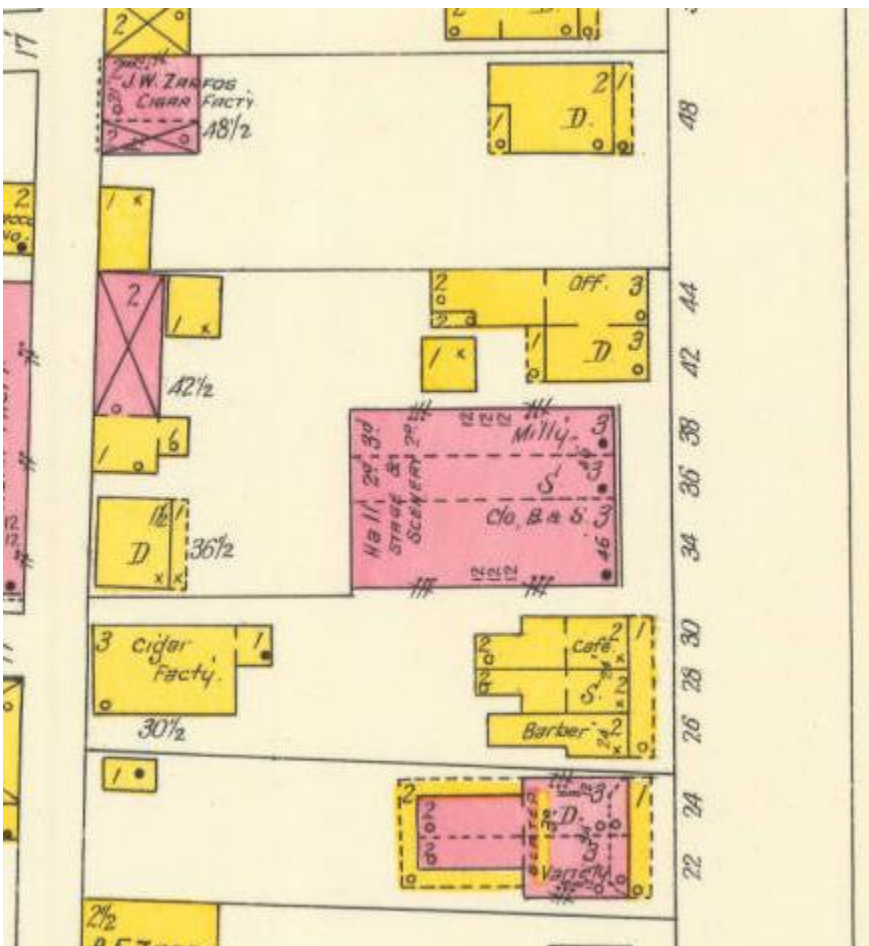

Individual Information

1. **William Knaub** – Born about 1845 in York County, PA (per 1880 census), died between 1898 and 1900 in York County, PA (he is listed as living in Yoe in the 1898 city directory and his wife is listed as a widow in the 1900 census)
2. **Rebecca Ruby** – Born September 15, 1849 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died April 6, 1921 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Yoe Union Cemetery in Yoe, York County, PA.
3. **Charles Edward Knaub** – Born May 1868 in York County, PA (per 1900 census) and died unknown. He married **Emma Beshore** who was born October 6, 1872 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died January 25, 1929 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Yoe Union Cemetery in Yoe, York County, PA.
4. **Lydia Knaub** – Born August 4, 1869 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died March 19, 1929 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Yoe Union in Yoe, York County, PA. She married **John Reichard** who was born either April 1869 (per 1900 census) or April 27, 1872 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died June 3, 1939 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Yoe Union Cemetery in Yoe, York County, PA
5. **William Knaub** – Born December 10, 1871 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died April 26, 1941 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Prospect Hill Cemetery in Manchester Twp, York County, PA. He married **Clara Mitzel** who was born July 26, 1879 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died October 13, 1962 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Prospect Hill Cemetery in Manchester Twp, York County, PA
6. **Theodore Knaub** – Born February 1, 1876 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died July 22, 1940 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Yoe Union Cemetery in Yoe, York County, PA. He married **Susan Billet** who was born February 8, 1884 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died April 9, 1915 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Mount Zion Cemetery in Springettsbury Twp, York County, PA

Location of residence

- Home of William Knaub was probably located at what is now 32 N. Main St. Per Sheriff's Deed 2-029 in 1887 when his property was sold at sheriff's sale, William's land was bound by J.W. Zarfos on the north, a public alley on the west, N. Main St. on the east and Emanuel Smith on the south. It is verified that J.W. Zarfos's property was located at what is now 40-42 N. Main St. (listed as 48 on map below). Since William's land was to the south of that, his house was either located at what is now either 30 N. Main St. (number 34-36-38 below) or 32 N. Main St. (numbered as 42-44 below). In looking at the 1908 Sanborn Fire Insurance map below, previously there was a frame building at what is now 32 N. Main St. and the building located at what is now 30 N. Main St, while still the same building as the one in 1908, it clearly shows this was the location of the Red Lion theatre and not a dwelling. For reference, yellow buildings are frame/wood buildings and red buildings are made of brick.



Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- In 1880, William was elected as School Director for a two year term in the borough's first elections.
- William owned and operated a cigar box manufacturing business until at least 1886.

Miscellaneous Notes

- William and his family moved to the borough of Yoe, probably sometime after 1886. None of his children resided in Red Lion as adults.
