Location of residence

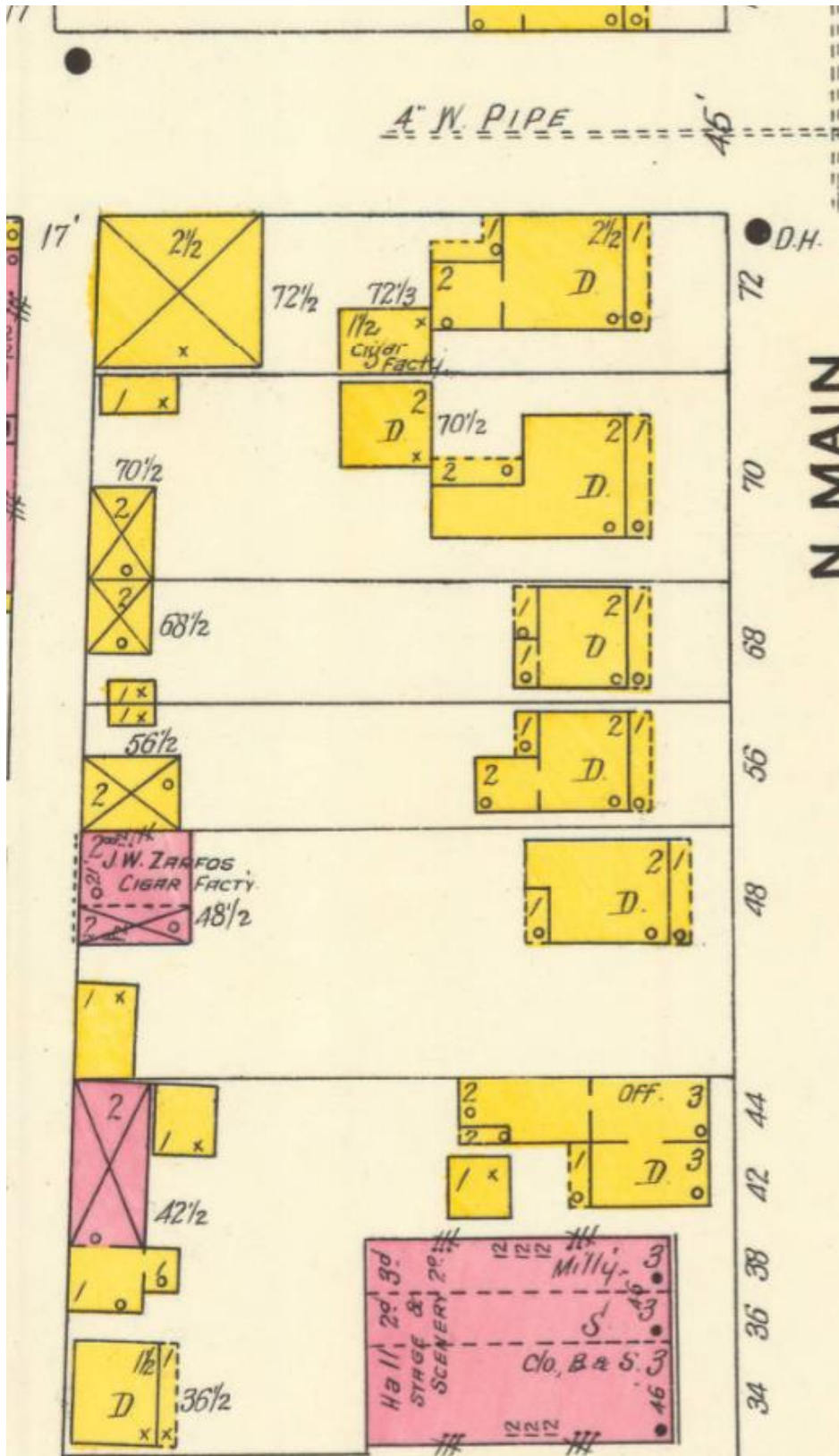
- Based on the households visited before and after the Jacob Cramer household in the census, the family probably was living in the vicinity of the intersection of N. Main St. and First Avenue. In fact, a newspaper article from the York Dispatch in 1882 states that Jacob Cramer sold his lot and house in Red Lion to J. W. Zarfoss. It is widely known that J. W. Zarfoss lived at what is now 40-42 N Main St. in Red Lion.

Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- In the 1880 census, Jacob is listed as a cigar maker. In the 1898 city directory, Jacob is still listed as living in Red Lion as a cigar maker.

Miscellaneous Notes

- Based upon the previously mentioned newspaper article, it appears Jacob and his wife left Red Lion in 1882.
