1. **Hiram Dill** – Born March 16, 1824 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died September 2, 1884 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Manifold Burial Ground in Fawn Twp, York County, PA

2. **Eve Shirey** – Born January 15, 1822 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died February 4, 1884 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Manifold Burial Ground in Fawn Twp, York County, PA

3. **William Dill** – Born about 1859 in York County, PA (per 1880 census)

Location of residence

- Hiram owned and operated the Rising Sun Hotel, which was located at what is now the northeast corner of W Broadway and N. Franklin St. Below is the Beach Nichols 1876 Atlas of York County showing the location of the hotel. It is unclear if Hiram and his family lived in the hotel or in another house on his property.

Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- Hiram owned and operated the Rising Sun Hotel.
- In 1880, Hiram was elected as a school director for a three-year term in the borough's first elections.

Miscellaneous Notes

- William was sentenced to 14 months in the Eastern State Penitentiary in 1886 for burglary and larceny. It does not seem he returned to Red Lion after serving this prison term.
- After his death, Franklin Messersmith bought and operated the Rising Sun Hotel.
