### Individual Information

1. **Jeremiah Smith** – Born about 1822 in York County, PA (per 1880 census), died December 4, 1895 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Adamsville United Methodist Church Cemetery in York Twp, York County, PA
2. **Henrietta Geesey/Keesey** – Born about 1821 in York County, PA (per 1880 census), died January 20, 1892 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Adamsville United Methodist Church Cemetery in York Twp, York County, PA
3. **Frank Smith** – Born May 9, 1852 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died February 27, 1914 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA. He married **Ida** (unknown last name) who was born March 24, 1865 in PA (per tombstone), died June 27, 1891 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Adamsville United Methodist Church Cemetery in York Twp, York County, PA
4. **Sevilla Smith** - Born January 22, 1861 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died March 22, 1881 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Adamsville United Methodist Church Cemetery in York Twp, York County, PA. She married **William Olp** who was born February 3, 1861 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died January 19, 1937 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Red Lion Cemetery in Red Lion, York County, PA

### Location of residence

- Exact location of his residence in 1880 is unknown. Based on 1870 census records, Jeremiah and his family appeared to be neighbors with Henry Wagman and Charles Neff. The Beach Nichols 1876 Atlas of York County below shows a J. Smith living near both H. Wagman and Chas. Neff. If the map accurately indicates the dwelling of Jeremiah Smith and his family was still living at this dwelling in 1880, then they would have been included in the Red Lion census in error since this property was never located within the borough limits of Red Lion. It is possible that Jeremiah moved sometime between 1876 and 1880 to a residence within Red Lion.



#### Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- Jeremiah is listed as a blacksmith in the 1880 census and also the 1886 city directory for Red Lion.
- Frank is listed as a blacksmith in the 1880 census, a laborer in the 1900 census and a cigar maker in the 1910 census.

#### Miscellaneous Notes

- Sevilla's husband William Olp was also an original resident of Red Lion when the census was taken in 1880.
