

1. **Moses Smith** – Born October 27, 1852 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died May 6, 1918 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Greenmount Cemetery in York, York County, PA.
2. **Mary Goodling** – Born February 20, 1855 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died June 13, 1885 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Emmanuel United Methodist Church Cemetery in Loganville, York County, PA
3. **Byron Smith** – Born September 27, 1876 in York County, PA (per social security records), died May 19, 1938 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Mount Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden Twp, York County, PA. He married **Elizabeth Jane Anstine** who was born March 26, 1876 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died June 19, 1948 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Mount Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden Twp, York County, PA
4. **Daniel Smith** – Born September 17, 1878 in York County, PA (per death certificate), died October 27, 1952 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Prospect Hill Cemetery in Manchester Twp, York County, PA. He married **Mary Elizabeth Baumeister** who was born November 24, 1874 in York County, PA (per Bethlehem United Methodist Church records), died February 16, 1950 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Prospect Hill Cemetery in Manchester Twp, York County, PA

Location of residence

- The book titled *Red Lion: The First Hundred Years* believes Moses Smith lived at what is now 286-288 N Main St. Deed transactions confirm this to be correct because when Moses sold this property in 1897 to Charles Detwiler, that deed transaction mentions that Moses bought it on April 1, 1878. The Beach Nichols 1876 Atlas of York County below shows the location of the home with the owner listed as H. Poet. The home across Main St. owned by David Miller is the well-known “Red Lion Tavern”



Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- Moses is listed as a cigar maker in the 1880 census and as a cigar maker, farmer and laborer in future census records and city directories.
- In 1880, Moses was elected to a one-year term as School Director

Miscellaneous Notes

- In 1904, Moses is still listed as a resident of Red Lion. However, by 1905 he is no longer a resident and had moved his family to York. Byron and Daniel lived in the vicinity of York city as adults
- After Mary died in 1885, Moses married Eliza Hartzler in 1887.
