



Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- William is listed as a farmer in the 1880 census and as a farmer in later city directories.
- In 1880, William was elected as a school director for a three-year term in the borough's first elections.
- In 1884, William was one of the petitioners to secede from Red Lion borough and his property went back to York Township. Later on, much of his original property was added back into Red Lion borough.
- Henry is listed as a farm helper in the 1880 census.
- John is listed as a farm helper in the 1880 census and later census records indicate he worked as a cigar maker. John and his wife lived at what is now 255 S. Main St.

Miscellaneous Notes

 By 1900, Henry and his mother Lydia had moved to York City. Samuel Poet also moved out of Red Lion by 1900
