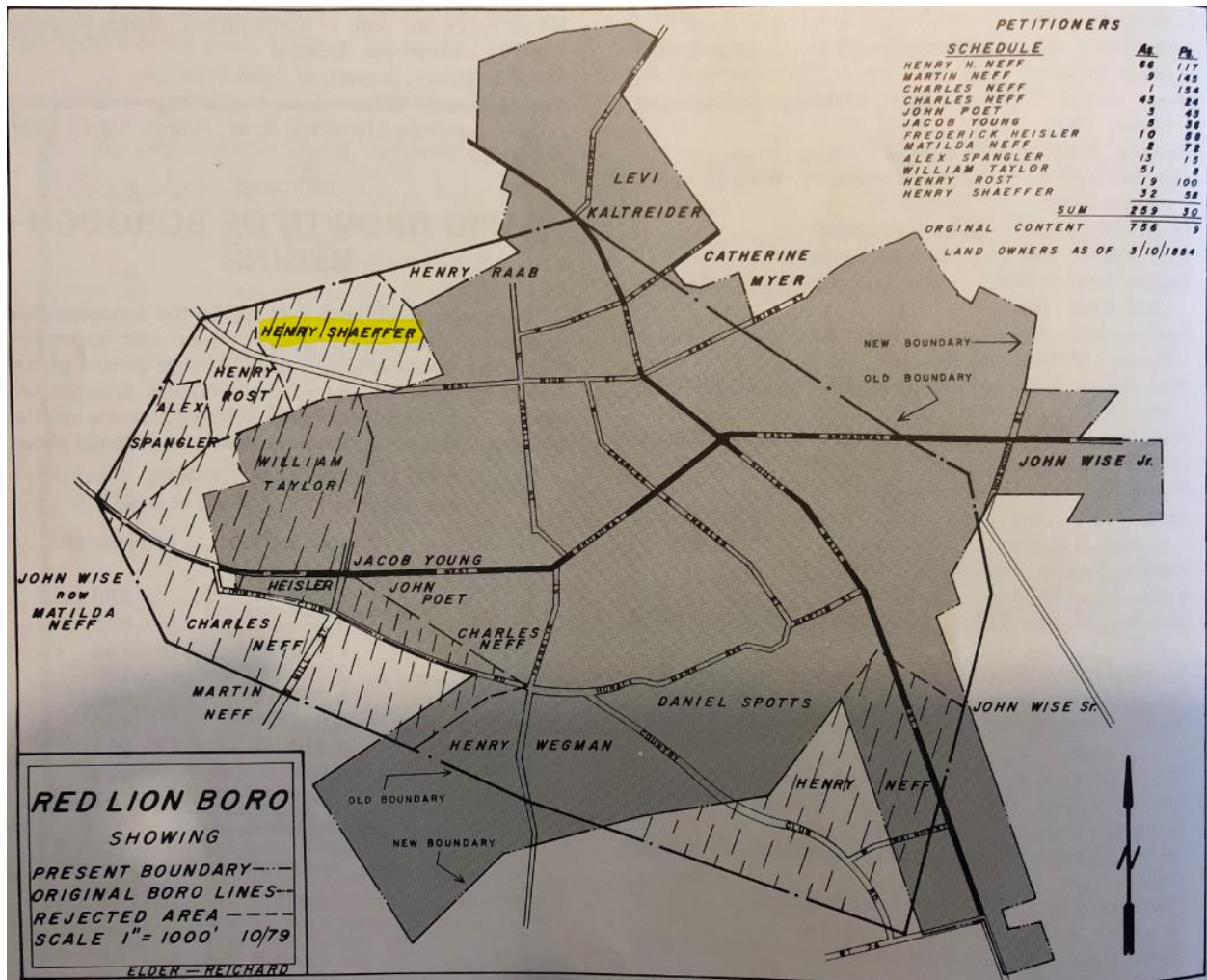

### Individual Information

1. **Henry Shaffer** – Born February 20, 1821 in York County, PA (per tombstone), died October 20, 1897 in York County, PA (per tombstone) and buried at Yoe Union Cemetery in Yoe, York County, PA.
2. **Christiana Spade** – Born December 28, 1814 in Germany (per death certificate), died October 22, 1909 in York County, PA (per death certificate) and buried at Yoe Union Cemetery in Yoe, York County, PA
3. **William Shaffer** – Born about 1857 in York County, PA (per 1880 census)

### Location of residence

- Below is a picture taken from the book titled *Red Lion: The First One Hundred Years*, that shows the Red Lion borough limits in 1880, the current borough limits and the name of the land owners as of March 10, 1884 who wanted to secede from Red Lion. This shows Henry Shaffer owning land north of Springwood Road, west of the current borough limits. This corresponds with the route the census taker took, since William Taylor (property to the south of Henry) was visited by the census taker right before Henry, and then the census taker next visited Henry Rost (property to the west of Henry), indicating it is very likely that Henry Shaffer lived in the highlighted property above in 1880. There are several homes located along Springwood Rd just to the west of town that could have been the 1880 home of Henry Shaffer. The homes at 349 W. High St. and 3585 Springwood Road were located on the property owned by Henry Shaffer, and the home at 3565 Springwood Road might also have been on Henry Shaffer's property as well.



### Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- Henry is listed as a farmer in the 1880 census.
- In 1884, Henry was one of the petitioners to secede from Red Lion borough and his property went back to York Township.

### Miscellaneous Notes

- No further information could be found on William Shaffer (too many William Shaffer's born around the same time period and nothing that connects them back to Henry and Christiana as parents).
