

• Below is a picture taken from the book titled *Red Lion: The First One Hundred Years*, that shows the Red Lion borough limits in 1880, the current borough limits and the name of the land owners as of March 10, 1884 who wanted to secede from Red Lion. This shows Henry Rost owning land along Springwood Road, west of the current borough limits. This corresponds with the route the census taker took, since Henry Shaeffer (property to the east of Henry Rost) was visited by the census taker right before Henry Rost was visited. Henry Rost's household was the last one visited by the census taker in Red Lion, and by the order of the previous houses visited this makes sense as it appears the census taker was heading northwest out of town when he reached Henry Rost's household. According to the same book mentioned above, Henry's home was located along the south side of Springwood home.



Occupation and Civic Involvement in Red Lion

- Henry is listed as a farmer in the 1880 census.
- In 1884, Henry was one of the petitioners to secede from Red Lion borough and his property went back to York Township.
- Charles was a cigar manufacturer and owned and operated C. A. Rost & Company. Charles served as a director for the People's State Bank of Red Lion. He first lived at 201 W High St and then eventually moved to 171 N Charles St.
- William lived in Red Lion from about 1923 through 1930 at what is now 19 Boundary Ave. He worked as a cigar maker.
- Elizabeth lived in Red Lion at several locations. According to the 1910 and 1920 census records, she worked as a cigar maker.

Miscellaneous Notes

- Emma Rost and her husband John Smith resided in York Twp and Dallastown borough.
- Louisa Rost and her brother Thomas Rost both resided in Dallastown.
- Annie Rost and her husband Edwin Bixler lived in Hellam Twp.
- Charles's wife Alice Neff is also an original Red Lion resident from 1880 (lived with Charles Neff).
