

- Daniel is listed as a Farmer on the 1880 census and was elected as one of the first Councilmen in Red Lion in 1880.
- Ulysses is listed as a cigar manufacturer in Red Lion and lived at what is now 214 S. Main St. as early as 1904 and until at least 1915. By 1920 he moved out of Red Lion and was living in York Township.
